The IMSC has been established to maintain Freedom of Navigation (FON), international law and free flow of maritime commerce to support regional stability and security. A multinational construct which is committed to ensuring that mariners on innocent passage have unrestricted use of international waters. The IMSC is complementary to existing international maritime missions and reporting systems in the region that provide maritime security assurance.

Ships should continue to report to the UKMTO using the standard Initial Report.
