

Beta release (v0.6) Overview

Thank you for agreeing to test the latest beta version of the ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions software, which is being developed by the UK Hydrographic Office (UKHO) to enhance the way Sailing Directions data is viewed and used.

By participating in this beta test, you will gain access to an early version of the software and can provide feedback directly to us to help shape future ADMIRALTY products and services.

Please note: This beta version is still under development and therefore does not yet meet the requirements for carriage compliance. If testing the software as part of 'LIVE' passage planning activities, please ensure it is being used in conjunction with compliant ADMIRALTY Sailing Directions publications (via ADMIRALTY e-NPs or paper publications).

Beta Testing Timeline

This phase of beta testing will begin in July 2025 and continue until the end of September 2025.

The ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions beta (v0.6) software will cease after the end of this phase of the beta testing. Additional versions of the beta software may be provided within the beta testing period.

Installation & Activation

To access the installation files for ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions beta (v0.6) software please register [here](#).

Once downloaded, the .zip file must be unzipped/extracted to allow the **setup.exe** file to work. Launching **setup.exe** file will open the setup wizard.

This version of the ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions beta (v0.6) software requires activation before use. The following username and password should be used to activate the software:

Password: Password123

If you have participated in testing a previous version of ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions, please uninstall the previous version through the Windows 'Add or remove programs' tool before downloading and installing the beta (v0.6) software.

System Requirements

ADSD runs on the Microsoft Windows operating system.

ADSD will run on computers with minimum specifications meeting those required by the operating system.

However, for improved performance, it is recommended that the minimum machine specification is as follows:

Processor: 2 Ghz or faster with 4 or more cores

RAM: 8Gb or more

Storage: 256Gb or more

Graphics Card: Compatible with DirectX 12 or later with WDDM 2.0 driver

Display: 720p (1280x720)

Data and Coverage

The ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions beta (v0.6) software includes data for 24 ADMIRALTY Sailing Directions areas covering the key shipping routes from the United Kingdom to Singapore and China.

The data contained in this ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions beta (v0.6) software is not fully up to date. Some updates to the data will be provided for this version of the beta software to test the ease of updating and display of updates within the product.

Not all data contained in the ADMIRALTY Digital Sailing Directions beta (v0.6) software has undergone final quality control checks – if you identify any errors or inconsistencies, please highlight them in your feedback to us by emailing ADSDfeedback@ukho.gov.uk.
